Day Golf The Links at Spanish Bay Golf Links

The land available to the designers of this course was perfect links terrain: a gently rolling, ocean-side, windswept area of sand dunes and marshes.

The Scottish influence can be observed everywhere on the course. The small greens are nestled between dunes, pot bunkers hide behind grassy mounds, and tees, fairways and greens were seeded with fescue grasses to provide the firm playing surface found on the old-world links. After golf you may like to tour the 17-Mile Drive. Following the incised granite coastline from Pacific Grove to Carmel, the 17 Mile Drive through the private enclave of Pebble Beach is famous enough that the town can charge a \$7.00 fee just to drive it.

Day Golf at Spyglass Hill Golf Club

This Robert Trent Jones design was beautiful but controversial when it opened in 1963. Alterations have settled the controversy, but the beauty remains just the same. Most fairways are tight and the pine trees often seem to stand in the line of play. Spyglass is long, technical and some think too unforgiving; but one thing is sure; it remains one of Robert Trent Jones's best achievements and one of the most difficult and beautiful tests of golf that the public can play. After golf you may like to visit Cannery Row. Explore the nearly 75 shops, restaurants & attractions that highlight one of California's most extraordinary regions. One of America's most famous streets, it was popularized by author John Steinbeck. Here, hardworking whalers, fisherman and cannery owners and workers struggled to enhance their lives and build a thriving industry. Welcome to this historic street, full of vitality & excitement.

Day **Golf at Pebble Beach Golf Links**

Jack Nicklaus has called Pebble Beach his favorite course. Many think it is the best in the country and certainly the most beautiful. The course sits by Carmel Bay and probably has the most scenic setting in all of golf. The course is difficult, but no matter how you play, it is the golfer's experience of a lifetime. After golf you may want to visit Carmel which is situated on the Bay of Carmel and nestled in a pine forest above the beaches. This one-square mile village offers quaint streets with unique shops, fine restaurants and Historic Inns and hotels.
